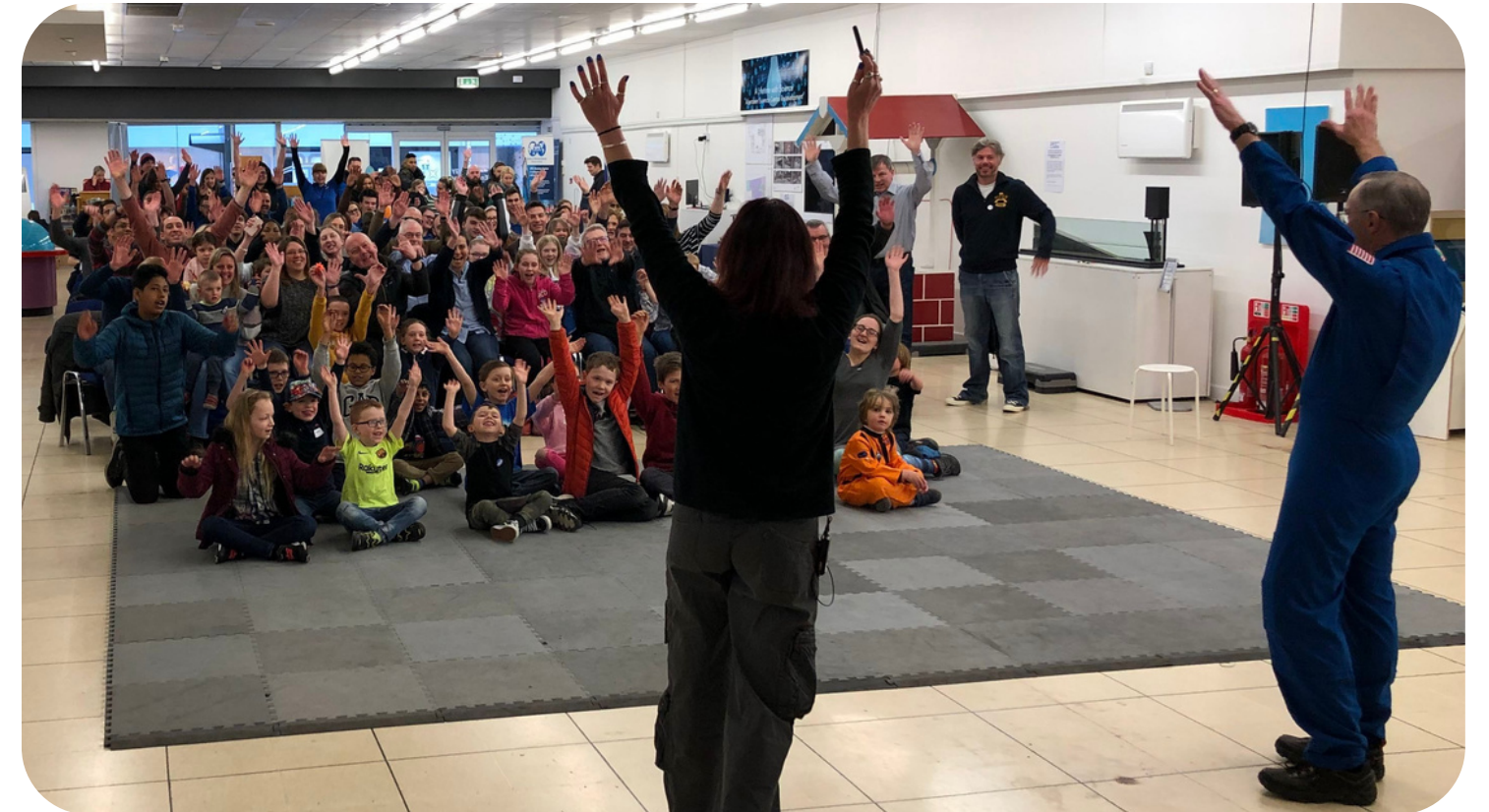
Each year we hold an event dedicated to giving information and one-to-one advice on all aspects of becoming a chartered engineer.
