Who is CODA

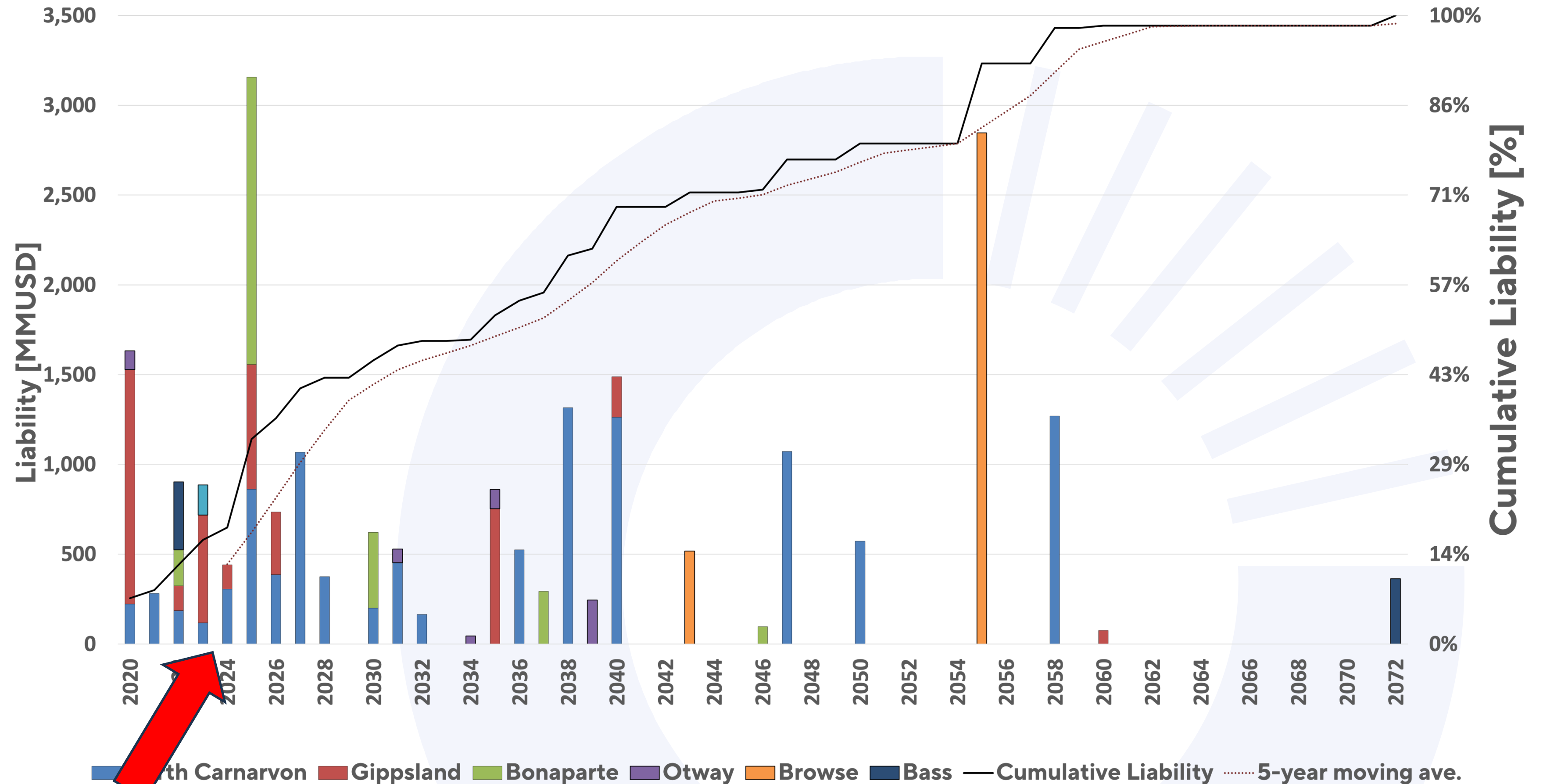
Australian independent not for profit decommissioning peak body established in 2020 to support the development and growth of Australia's decommissioning industry through cross industry collaboration.

- These projects need an entire ecosystem of companies for them to be executed safely, efficiently and where possible, locally

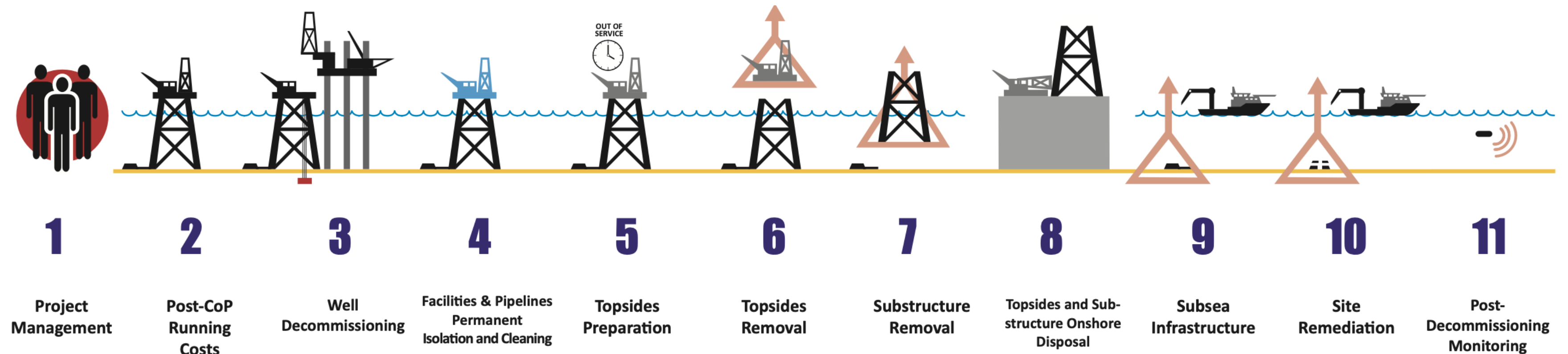
Offshore decommissioning workload

- Evolving and complex regulatory landscape




Areas of opportunity

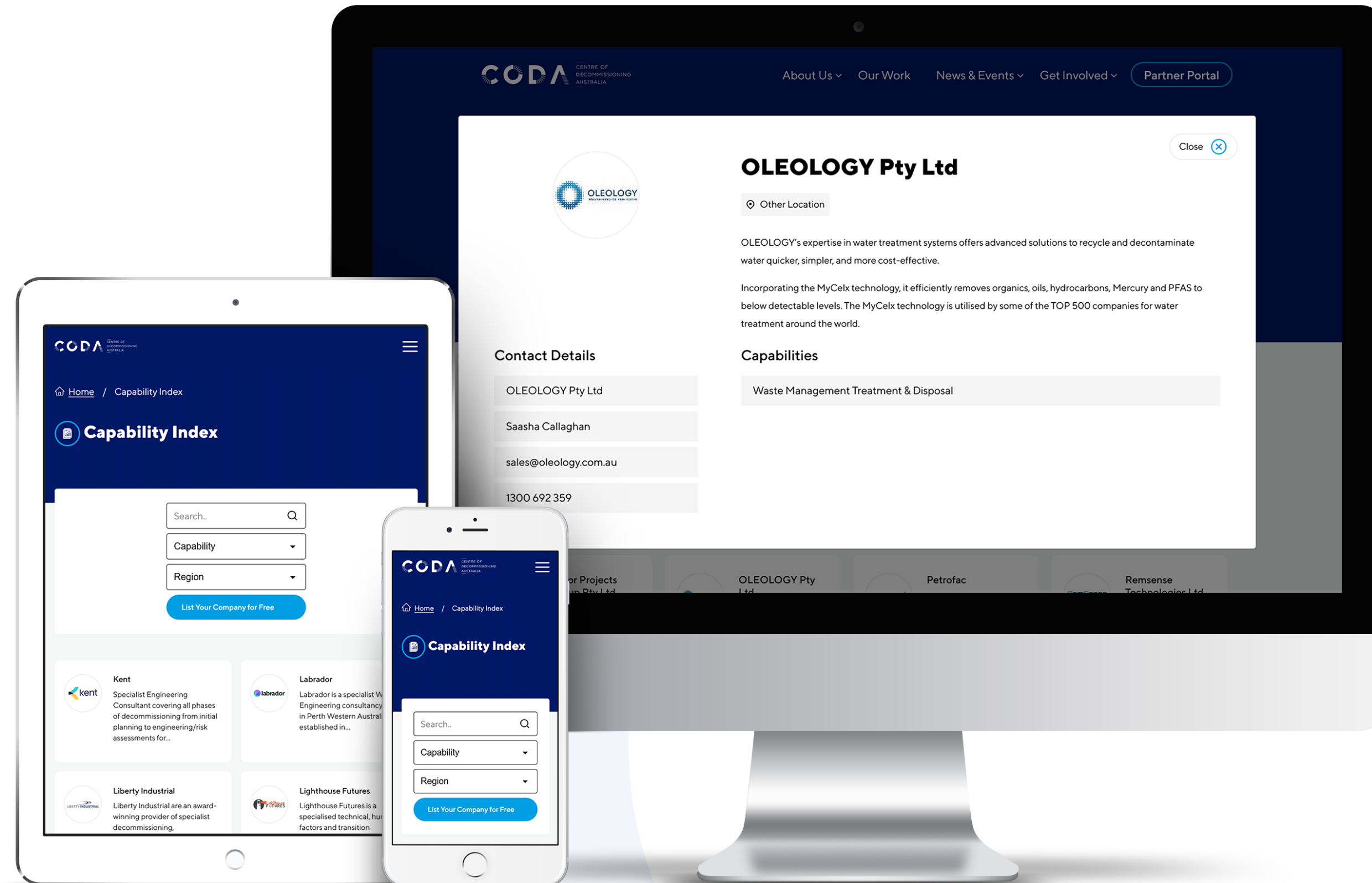

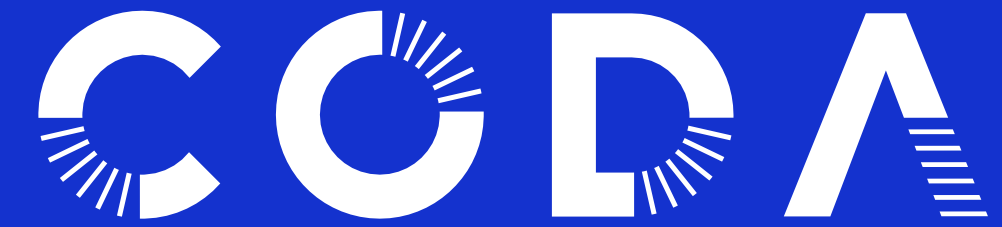
