Furthermore, it is endowed with a number of learned societies/institutions such as the Royal Society, Royal Geographical Society, The British Geological Survey, The

British Library, The Institution of Civil Engineers etc., etc., and nearly all within walking distance of each other. Should you not wish to walk, London is served by an extensive network of reasonably priced public transport.
